From the Manager

Hello Valued Tenants,

Spring is a time of transformation and growth, and here in our community, we are embracing the season with open arms. We are delighted to bring you the latest updates, events, and highlights from our wonderful community:

AROUND THE COMMUNITY:

- SITE CURB APPEAL: Please be reminded to ensure that skirting around the entire house is in good shape with no gaps, etc. Due to recent rain, please maintain the grass around your site by mowing and weed-eating regularly.
- PETS: Please remember to abide by the lease and register your pets with the office. All pets must be authorized. Also, note that there is an additional monthly \$10.00 pet fee per pet.

EVENTS TO CHECK:

TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE: This will take place at the Moon's ascending node on Monday, April 8, 2024, visible across North America and dubbed the Great North American Eclipse (also Great American Total Solar Eclipse and Great American Eclipse) by some media sources.

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between Earth and the Sun, thereby obscuring the image of the Sun for a viewer on Earth. A total solar eclipse occurs when the Moon's apparent diameter is larger than the Sun's, blocking all direct sunlight, turning day into darkness. Totality occurs only in a narrow path across Earth's surface, with the partial solar eclipse visible over a surrounding region thousands of kilometers wide.

Occurring only one day after perigee (perigee on Sunday, April 7, 2024), the Moon's apparent diameter will be 5.5% larger than average. With a magnitude of 1.0566, its longest duration of totality will be four minutes and 28.13 seconds near the Mexican town of Nazas, Durango, (~6 km north), and the nearby city of Torreón, Coahuila.

This eclipse will be the first total solar eclipse visible in the provinces of Canada since February 26, 1979, the first in Mexico since July 11, 1991, and the first in the U.S. since August 21, 2017.

It will be the only total solar eclipse in the 21st century where totality will be visible in Mexico, the United States, and Canada. It will also be the last total solar eclipse visible in the Contiguous United States until August 23, 2044.

The final solar eclipse of the year will occur six months later, on October 2, 2024.

BOTANICAL GARDENS YEARLY PLANT SALE: South Texas Botanical Gardens & Nature Center offers a special event: the annual BIG BLOOM mega PLANT SALE & GARDEN FESTIVAL. For only \$2 Community Day entry fee, you can enjoy the event from 10 am to 5 pm on Saturday, April 6, at South Texas Botanical Gardens & Nature Center, located at 8545 S. Staples St., Corpus Christi.

The event will feature hundreds of plant varieties, from bougainvillea to begonias to bromeliads, orchids, plumeria, tropicals, butterfly attractors, xeriscape, and colorful foliage.
